2. On the date of 10/28/99, I was convicted of the misdemeanor offense(s) of violation of section(s) 415(a) of the California Penal Code.
3. I was: (check one) (1203.4) placed on probation, and I have fulfilled all the conditions of probation for the entire time required. (1203.4a) sentenced more than one year ago, without probation, and I have fully complied with the sentence.
4. I am not now charged with, serving a sentence for, or on probation for any offense.
